The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead proves He had victory over death and victory over sin, showing He has the power to save us from our sins.

"Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:" Romans 1:3-4

If you are willing to put your trust in Christ's payment for your sin to take you to Heaven, you can invite Him into your life by praying this simple prayer:

"Dear Jesus, I know that I'm a sinner. I know I deserve to go to Hell, but I want to thank You for dying on the cross to pay for my sins. Please come into my heart and save me from the penalty of my sin, and take me to Heaven when I die."

Just as an earthly father wants to have a relationship with his children, God wants to have a relationship with you. We do this by talking to Him (through prayer) and by Him talking to us (through the Bible.)
